



# SINGLE LEVER SINK MIXER

## Installation Guide

### 1. Preparation - Before starting the installation:

- Ensure all components are included in the package.
- Shut off the main water supply.
- Clean the installation surface thoroughly.
- Confirm that the sink or counter top hole matches the mixer's mounting size.  
**Important:** Flush all water lines before installation to remove dirt, debris, or residue. Failure to do so may damage the cartridge and void the warranty.

### 2. Mounting the Mixer

- Insert the mixer body into the mounting hole.
- Align the mixer so it faces the correct direction.

#### From underneath the sink:

- Fit the rubber gasket
- Add the metal washer
- Secure with the fixing nut
- Tighten using a basin wrench, ensuring the mixer remains straight and stable.

### 3. Connecting the Flexible Hoses

- Connect the hoses to the correct water supply:  
Left = Hot water  
Right = Cold water
- Hand-tighten first, then lightly tighten with a spanner.  
**Caution:** Do not over-tighten, as this may damage threads or O-rings.

### 4. Cartridge & Aerator Check

- Ensure the ceramic cartridge is properly secured.
- Check that the aerator is clean and free of debris.
- If needed, remove the aerator and flush the system again after installation.

### 5. Testing the Mixer

- Slowly turn the water supply back on.
- Operate the lever several times to check:
  - Smooth movement
  - Consistent water flow

### 6. Inspect for leaks:

- At the base
- At hose connections
- Under the sink

Wipe all components dry after testing

### 7. Final Notes

- Use only clean water with balanced pressure as specified for the mixer.
- Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners on the finish.
- Clean the aerator regularly to maintain optimal performance.

### Care & Maintenance

- Clean with a soft cloth and mild soapy water.
- Avoid abrasive pads, bleach, or strong chemicals.
- Dry after cleaning to prevent water spots and limescale.
- Regularly inspect hoses and fittings for wear or leaks.
- In hard water areas, clean the aerator frequently or consider a water softener.

## 10-Year Warranty

This mixer is covered by a 10-year warranty, subject to the terms outlined below.

### Warranty Terms

Products must be installed in accordance with current water regulations by a qualified plumber, with sufficient access for future maintenance. The warranty does not cover faults caused by incorrect installation, misuse, neglect, willful damage, wear and tear, inappropriate cleaning, or failure to follow the recommended installation instructions. Damage resulting from lime scale, poor water quality, or any external conditions beyond the manufacturer's control is not covered. Labour, removal, or re installation costs are not included under this warranty. This warranty does not cover consequential losses or damage. The warranty is non-transferable and applies only to the original purchaser. Display models and re-installed items are excluded from this warranty. All claims must be submitted through the original supplier and must be accompanied by a copy of the original proof of purchase.
